GURU LIBEL CASE JUDGMENT.

DEFENDANTS' WIN.

(From Our Own Correspondent.)

Kuala Lumpur, October 1,

In the Supreme Court this morning the Chief Justice, Sir Henry Gompertz, gave judgment in the famous Guru libel case in which Haji Jalaluddin bin Ismail (a religious teacher of Jendram, Ulu Langat) sued seven other Malays for publishing a libel against him and claiming \$3,200 damages.

He also prayed for an injunction restraining the defendants from publishing similar libellous statements.

His Lordship in the course of a lengthy judgment found for the defendants. The question of costs is to be argued in chambers to-morrow.
