SECURITY FORCES BAG 5 BANDITS

KUALA LUMPUR, Wed. — Five bandits were killed and four wounded in aggressive actions by Security Forces in the Federation in the 24 hours up to 10 a.m. today.

Two bandits were killed in the Kuala Kubu district of Selangor this morning. Members of a Security Forces Patrol moving through the jungle heard the sound of voices coming from a hut. A grenade was fired into the camp and the bandits fled in all directions. A close inspection of the hut revealed that the two bandits, a Malay and a Chinese had been killed.

Blood trails from two wounded bandits were followed without further contact being made. Two rifles, one grenade and 100 rounds of ammunition were discovered.

Two more bandits were killed on an estate in the Alor Gajah district of Malacca this morning when Police, acting on information, surrounded a bandit camp. One armed person, in attempting to escape, was arrested.

During screening operations in Negri Sembilan, a bandit was shot dead while attempting to escape.

Of the two Malay bandits killed recently in the Kajang District of south Selangor one has been identified as Abdul Manan Pakeh who was in charge of the Malay "Min Yuen" element of the Jenderam Bukit Raya area.

Five arrests were made out of 1,500 people screened in the Kluang area of Johore yesterday.
