# Jenderam Not To Be Destroyed

THE R.A.F. in a statement issued yesterday said that it has no knowledge of any proposal to destroy from the air, the evacuated village of Jenderam in South Selangor.

This was in reply to a report in The Sunday Standard yesterday.

An R.A.F. spokesman said: "Neither the Army nor the Air Force is aware of any proposal to use the services to destroy the village."

The Federation Government had announced that the village would be wiped out.

Jenderam which was alleged to be a "hotbed of bandit helpers and sympathisers," was cleared of its inhabitants a few days ago.

They were evacuated to other areas for screening and eventual resettlement.
