# 37 Jenderam Youths Freed

KUALA LUMPUR, (Wed.)—Thirty-five Malay boys and girls have arrived here from Kluang where they have been since Feb. 15 when 1,500 residents of Jenderam were evacuated.

In all, 37 were released, two of them having been handed over to their guardians who met them at the camp.

Those who came here were accommodated and fed at the

Malay Boys Hostel, Kampong Bahru.

Arrangements have already been made for the children to put up with relatives and to continue their interrupted education as the result of the evacuation.

Five are being sent to Perak, a similar number to Negri Sembilan, while the rest will find accommodation with relatives in Selangor.
