# Evacuation Of Tras Completed

**KUALA LUMPUR.** Fri.—The evacuation of Tras, notorious bandit area in West Pahang was completed today.

This once thriving village of about 2,000 inhabitants, mostly Chinese, employed on rubber estates and mines, will be another "dead" town like Pulai and Jenderam before it.

Tras, since the murder of the late Sir Henry Gurney, had been put on the "black list." Its evacuation will deny the bandits in Western Pahang a valuable supply base.

With Tras cleaned the hunt for the Gurney murder gang, which has been on the run from the 2/2 Gurkhas and the Police, may reach its crucial stage soon.

The operation is now in its fifth phase. There is not a moment's "let up" in this biggest man hunt ever conducted in Malaya.

Security forces operating in this area have killed to date seven bandits believed to be members of the Gurney killers.
