# Rulers give \$1,000 to detainees

**KUALA LUMPUR, Tues.**  
**THE** Malay Rulers have given \$1,000 to the Malay Detainees Welfare Fund, Inche Abdul Aziz bin Ishak, secretary of the Malay Detainees Welfare Committee, told the Straits Times today.

Inche Aziz said that the committee was now preparing a report for the Selangor Government urging higher rates of compensation for ex-Jenderam detainees.

Over 300 families of ex-Jenderam detainees, most of whom have now been released, recently asked the committee to see the State Government for higher compensation.

They said that the State Government had only repaid them less than ten per cent of the value of the property they lost when they were resettled from Jenderam.

They submitted individual claims to the committee at an average of \$5,000 for each family, or about \$1,500,000 in all.

The committee is believed to have recommended settlement of about 60 per cent of the claims.
